### BOOK CLUB....

Last month's book was 'The Burning Girls' by C J Tudor. First published in January 2021 the book is a psychological thriller with supernatural/occult elements.

The main character is an unconventional Vicar who, with her daughter, finds herself moved to a small village in Sussex following a scandal in her previous city centre parish. The village of Chapel Croft has a religious history, being the site of the death of 6 Protestant martyrs at the time of the reign of Mary Tudor - all 6 were burnt at the stake, including two young girls who are 'The Burning Girls' of the title.

For a small village they have a high level of crime - with numerous disappearances, murders and assaults. Added to this are apparitions and hauntings which led to the book having a baffling number of concurrent stories. There is also a twist which is kept well hidden until very close to the end.

The general consensus was that the book is an easy, and fairly enjoyable read - albeit quite silly, with some large plot holes and familiar tropes.

Most people did finish the book and scores ranged from 4 to 8, with the average coming out at 6.5.

Next month's book is 'American Dirt' by Jeanine Cummins. It tells the story of a Mexican woman's desperate escape from Acapulco with her young son, following horrific violence from the local drug cartel.
