What's On for the Jubilee





BOOK CLUB....

This month's book was 'The Promise' by Damon Galgut. Published in 2021, and winner of the Booker Prize for that year, it tells the story of a white South African family, set against a backdrop of a period of intense change for their country and the impact on several generations of their family.

The book explores some huge topics such as nationalism and colonialism, against the backdrop of a single family's story. The dismantling of apartheid and the seismic changes in South Africa are explored through the lens of their impact on the Swart family over four decades.

The book prompted a really interesting and involved discussion. Many people didn't 'like' the book but still scored it highly. The characters were universally disliked, but the techniques employed by the author, such as the unidentified narrator and the spurning of traditional outcomes and neat endings, were admired and enjoyed. Even members who found the book annoying/irritating were still thinking about the book after finishing it.

The author has an unusual style which some members just couldn't get on with, and as a result a few people didn't finish it. This maybe skewed the scores, as only those who finished the book scored it.

The scores were all 7's and 8's, with the average coming out at just under 8.

Next month's book is 'Stanley - The Impossible Life of Africa's Greatest Explorer' by Tim Jeal; and the next meeting is Tuesday 14th June.
