

Welcome to the November newsletter.

Last meeting was particularly interesting and I plan to have Ian Kelvin return to entertain teach and conserve. Ian came up with some unusual and fun ideas. Some are as follows:-

Use nappy liners to line hanging baskets (unused)

Washing up liquid and water to spray on plants to kill off aphids.

2 to 1 water to vinegar and spray on weeds 2 to 1 mouthwash kills aphids spray every 14 days for up to 6 times to ensure eradication.

Sprinkle soda crystals on moss to kill it. (keep all 4 and 2 legged creatures off for 24hrs)

September's Book - 'Milkman' by Anna Burns

This month we read the Booker Prize winning novel Milkman by Anna Burns. It was agreed that this was a challenging read for a number of reasons. Set in Northern Ireland during the 1970s it portrayed the life of a young woman trying to live her life constrained by cultural and political forces around her. A very distinct voice is created through which the central character tells her convoluted tale. Lives are consumed by suspicion and rumour and harsh realities are dealt with in this story which even so has moments of humour. After a lively discussion the book was rated positively or negatively with no middle ground, giving an average score of six.

The book for this month had been recommended by Terry - Someone at a Distance by Dorothy Whipple. She is a Blackburn author and it has excellent reviews.


