
TOCKHOLES AND DISTRICT GARDEN CLUB....

August's Book - 'The Lost Man' by Jane Harper

Last month's book is a mystery set in the Australian outback. It is centred around the brothers of the Bright family, who own adjoining cattle stations in desert to the west of Brisbane - but in this case adjoining still means 3 hours drive apart. When one of the brothers is found dead the investigation starts to unearth family secrets and conflicts that have been hidden for many years.

The book was enjoyed by all of us. The picture it gave of this part of the world was vivid and stark; and the cruelty of the climate and landscape played a major part in the unravelling of the mystery. The focus on social elements was also enjoyed, and was thought provoking around topics as diverse as loneliness in rural communities and domestic abuse. All in all, the book was well received and scored 8.5.

This month's book is 'Milkman' by Anna Burns - the 2018 Booker Prize Winner, set in Northern Ireland during the troubles.

The next WI meeting is the AGM, this will be held on Tuesday 15th November at 7.15 in the Village Hall




